Louisville Indoor Games and Centre All-Age #2 Meet

The Collins track & field team traveled to the Norton SportsPlex on Feb. 3rd to compete in the Louisville Indoor Games. Some of the boys' team traveled to Danville on Feb. 4th to compete in the Centre All-Age #2 meet. The Titans continued to burn up the indoor school record book as three school records were broken, two at the Louisville meet and one at the Centre meet.

At the Louisville Indoor Games, sophomore Ziara Taylor upper her own school record in the triple jump to 31-10 which was good for 10th place. The other record was set by junior Emma Kendall as she clocked a 2:17.71 for second place in a stellar field in the 800. Her time made the US MileSplit Gold Standard. Nathan Janes cleared an indoor PR 12-0 in the pole vault for 14th place.

Junior Grace Evans also scored for the Titans jumping 10-0 in the pole vault to take seventh place. The 4 X 800 relay team of Ziara Taylor, Sophie Bolin, Luci Renda, and Grace White scored by finishing third. The Collins girls' team scored 16 points to place ninth out of 37 teams. They were the highest scoring team from Kentucky.

At the Centre meet, the boys' 4 X 800 relay team of Jack Fuhrmann, Chase Delaney, Melbyn Velasquez, and Nathan Janes finished second with a time of 8:36.49 (2:09 per leg). This chopped a huge 33 seconds off the previous record which was set back in 2013.
