State Indoor Meet

The Collins track & field team traveled to Louisville on March 4th to compete in the KHSAA Indoor Track and Field State Meet at the Norton SportsPlex. The boys' team had four entrants, seniors Lincoln Laubach and Jaquan McNeal, junior Cole Weber, and sophomore Liam Royse in the 4 X 400 meter relay. Junior Reece Delaney also qualified in the 1600 and 4 X 400 relay but could not compete due to illness.

The boys 4 X 400 relay team ran 3:45.60 for 22nd place. This is the second fastest time in school history.

Lincoln Laubach ran a fast (51.9) anchor leg for Collins on the 4 X 400 relay at the State Meet.

Senior Sophie Bolin was the sole competitor for the Titan girls at the State Meet. She qualified in her best event, the 3200 (the metric equivalent of two miles). The Titan senior was in a tight pack which went through the first half of the race (1600 meters) in a pedestrian 6:04. Then the pace picked up. Bolin finished one place higher than last year, coming in tenth with a time of 11:59.41 (number three Collins all-time). She now has the top four indoor 3200 meter times in Collins' history.
