Eastern Relays

The Running Titans traveled to the University of Louisville on April 18th and 19th to compete in the Eastern Relays. Eastern Relays is a prestigious meet with minimum qualifying standards. On April 18th three Titans were in action Senior Grace Evans won the open pole vault with a 10-0 jump. Junior Sophie Bolin ran a personal best in the two-mile (3200) of 11:51.21 to finish 21st out of 85 runners.

On the meet's second day, senior Grace Nelson ran the best 300 hurdles race of her life to finish thirteenth in a PR 48.85 (number seven on the Collins all-time list). Senior Emma Kendall was the only Titan to score as she placed fifth in the 800 with a 2:15.96 which hit the US Silver Standard.





Grace Nelson bettered her time in the 300 hurdles by a big 1.52 seconds at the Eastern Relays.

On the boys' side sophomore Reece Delaney qualified to run the mile and finished in one of the faster times of his career (4:40.66). Senior Chase Delaney qualified in the two-mile finishing in 10:14.83. Senior Nathan Janes was the only scorer for the boys as he finished sixth (6:47.55) to get three points in the two-kilometer steeplechase.

The Running Titans will be in action next at St. Xavier in Louisville in the Brother Borgia / Coach Cooper Inv. on April 26^{th} .
