The Running Titans traveled to St. Xavier on April 26th to compete in the Brother Borgia / Coach Cooper Invitational. Senior Nathan Janes got the boys off to a good start in the pole vault as he tied his season best with a 12-6 vault which placed him third. He came back later in the meet to run a personal best in his first 300-meter hurdles of the year in 43.18 (sixth place). Janes later teamed up with junior Jaquan McNeal, sophomore Reece Delaney and senior Chase Delaney to put down a 3:37.70 4 X 400 relay to finish eighth. Their time was the number four time in Collins history.

Nelson later teamed up with Evans, and seniors Luci Renda and Emma Kendall to finish fifth in the 4 X 400 relay.
