Trimble Co. All Comers

The Running Titans headed to Bedford on May 13th to compete in the Trimble Co. All Comers Meet.

The boys were led by sophomore DaVaughn Wilson who competed in three events and got personal records (PRs) in each. He lowered his time in the 100 to 12.58, added almost five feet to his discus PR (99-5), and placed sixth to score in the shot put. He put the shot 37-4 to up his PR by eleven inches.

The 4 X 800 relay team of Jack Fuhrmann, Eli Moreno, Melbyn Velasquez, and Nathan Janes won with a time of 8:45.62. Marino (5th), Velasquez (3rd) teamed with eighth grader Ethan Kuzman (4th) to all score in the 3200. Janes won the 300 hurdles in a PR of 44.83. He also scored in the pole vault, sailing 10-6 for second place.

The girls' team finished with 94 points, which was good for third place out of 13 teams (most all comers meets are not scored). Freshmen Sofia Leon (6th in 13.82) and Maleah Wilson (4th in 13.66) both got PRs in the 100. Both also scored in the 200 with Leon finishing 4th in a PR 28.45 and Wilson finishing third in 27.92. Sophomore Emma Kendall got out of the blocks quickly in the 400 and was never heeded. She won by almost four seconds with a time of 59.45 which bested both her previous indoor (59.86) and outdoor school marks (1:02.49). Freshman Scout White ran a PR 1:09.23 (7th place) in the 400 to score for the Titans.

In the field events, senior Makayla Wilson took third in the shot put, while junior Hannah Rosenow placed fifth. Wilson also placed fifth in the discus. Freshman Sophie Bolin took fourth in the pole vault.

In the endurance events, junior Grace White picked up a point for an eighth place finish in the 1600. After the 400, Kendall came back to run the 3200. The heat took its toll in the 3200 as several athletes had to drop out. Kendall hung on for second place in a PR 11:31.93.

Freshman Ziara Taylor got PRs in both hurdles finishing fourth in the 100 hurdles (19.25) and second in the 300 hurdles. Her 300 hurdle time of 49.70 broke her school record for the event by .56 seconds.

The girls finished the meet with a strong showing in the 4 X 400 relay. The team of Leon, sophomore Luci Renda, Taylor, and Maleah Wilson sped the baton around the track in 4:26.11 to finish second in the third fastest time in Collins history.

Collins Head Track and Field Coach George Sanderlin said, "We had a great day with 50% of the athletes getting a PR. Ziara and Emma both did excellently. Each got a PR in one event and a school record in another. We are peaking at the right time with region as our next meet."

The Running Titans next meet is the Class 3A Region 4 meet at Eastern H.S. on May 22nd.
