3A Region 4 Meet

The Running Titans headed to Middletown on May 22nd to compete in the Class AAA Region 4 Meet. The boys were led by sophomore Nathan Janes who finished second in the pole vault and punched his ticket to the State Meet. He had no misses through eleven feet. He cleared a personal record 11-6 on his second attempt and then sailed over 12-0 on his second attempt. Janes upped his PR by a huge one foot.

The boys 4 X 800 relay team of Janes, Eli Moreno, Melbyn Velasquez, and Jack Fuhrmann scored with a sixth place finish. Janes also got points for the boys with a fourth in the 300 hurdles.

The girls finished in sixth place with 37 points, just two points behind fifth place Ballard. The girls were led by freshmen Ziara Taylor and Sofia Leon, as well as sophomore Captain Emma Kendall. Taylor flew through the 300 hurdles in 48.71 to lower her school record by almost a second. Sofia Leon, who was using the 200 as a tune-up for the 4 X 400 relay, took down the outdoor school record in the process. She ran a 27.59 to eclipse the old mark by .09. Kendall holds the overall record at 27.27 (set indoors).

Kendall repeated as Regional 800 champion in an exciting come from behind finish where she passed Assumption's Reagan Gilmore in the last 50 meters. Kendall's time of 2:14.83 is the number three mark in Collins history and met the US MileSplit Gold Standard. Her win earned her a trip to Lexington for the State Meet where she is the defending Class 3A 800 champion.

Sophomore Grace Evans earned a trip to the State Meet with a second place finish in the pole vault (9-0). Freshman Sophie Bolin also scored (5^{th}) in the pole vault. Sophomore Katelynn Gaddis scored in the 3200 in a PR 11:56.38 (5^{th}). Senior Captain Makayla Wilson scored in both the shot put (3^{rd}) and discus (4^{th}).
