The Running Titans traveled to Oldham County H.S. on April 30th to compete in the Sundown Invitational. Both the boys' and girls' teams finished sixth with 43 points each. Sophomore Liam Royse scored first for the boys as he got a personal record (PR) in the 110 hurdles, going 18.42 to finish seventh.

Senior Jaquan McNeal got seventh in the 100 (11.67). Senior Lincoln Laubach got a PR in the 400 with a time of 51.29 which was good for fourth place. In the 1600, both junior Reece Delaney (second) and senior George Diakhate (PR 4:56 for eighth) scored. Laubach also got a huge five foot PR in the triple jump with a leap of 43-10 to finish second. He later came back to anchor the Collins' 4 X 400 relay team (3:35.13) which finished second. In the throws, junior Wyatt Butler finished fifth in both the discus and shot put.

On the girls' side, both sophomore TyLiyah Thompson (second) and senior Sofia Leon (eighth) scored in the 100. Thompson came back later to scorch the 200 meters in 26.13 to knock .08 off her recently minted school record. In the 400, seniors Ziara Taylor (1:01.16 season best) and Leon finished fifth and eighth, respectively.

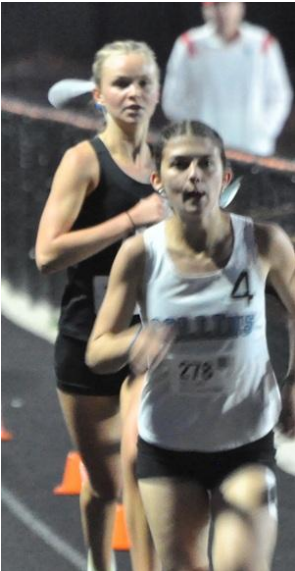

Senior Sophie Bolin ran with the lead pack for the first few laps then took over the 3200 race in the last half of it. She increased her lead every lap after that. She won in a PR 11:25.96 which is number eleven on the Collins all-time list.
