### **Bourbon County Colonel Charge**

The Collins cross country team traveled to Paris to compete in the Bourbon County Colonel Charge on Aug. 26th. The girls put all five scorers in the top 25 (four in the top 20) to finish with a low 45 points. This secured the win for the Titans as they finished 28 points ahead of runner-up Bishop Brossart. Junior Emma Kendall led the way, finishing fourth in 20:50. She was followed by sophomore Sophie Bolin in ninth (22:21), and seniors Grace White in 15<sup>th</sup> (23:19) and Laura Vidourek in 19<sup>th</sup> (24:14). Junior Luci Renda (23<sup>rd</sup> in 24:48) rounded out the scoring for the Titans.

The boys placed all five scorers in the top 20 to record a low 45 points to out distance host Bourbon County by 48 points for the win. This is the first time in Collins history that both the boys' and girls' teams won the same invitational cross country meet. The Titan boys were led by junior Nathan Janes who finished third in 17:46. He was closely followed by junior Chase Delaney in fourth place (17:54). Freshman Reece Delaney placed ninth (18:15), seniors Jack Fuhrmann in 12<sup>th</sup> (19:02), and Eli Moreno in 19<sup>th</sup> (19:36).
