Rumble Through the Jungle

The Collins cross country team traveled to the Creasy Mahon Nature Preserve in Goshen on Sept. 10th to compete in the Rumble Through the Jungle Invitational. The boys finished 16th out of 25 teams, bettering their 19th place finish of last year.

Sophomore Nathan Janes ran a time of 18:20 which was only one second shy of his personal record (PR). He was the first Titan across the line in 60th place in the large race. Eli Moreno was next for the Titans in 19:02 (85th) as he was closely followed by sophomore Chase Delaney in 86th place. Delaney got a big 24 second PR to finish in 19:03. Junior Jack Fuhrmann (19:33 an 18 second PR) and eighth-grader Reece Delaney (19:58) rounded out the Titan scoring.

Freshman Sophie Bolin got a medal for finishing 50th with a PR 22:21 to lead the Titan girls. All five of Collins' scorers were in the top 100 to place Collins twelfth out of 21 teams with 310 points. Sophomores Grace Nelson (55th) and Luci Renda (93rd), along with junior Laura Vidourek (80th) all got season bests. Sophomore Katelynn Gaddis was Collins' third finisher in 71st place.
