Duke Meyer Classic.

The Collins cross country team traveled to Hanover College in Indiana on Sept. 27th to run in the Duke Meyer Classic. As he has for the entire season, junior Reece Delaney led the way on the boys' side finishing in second place. His time of 16:26 was the second best of his career and made the US Silver Standard. It was also the sixth fastest time in Collins history.

The Titan boys placed seventh out of nine teams with 147 points. Delaney was followed by junior Ethan Kuzman who got the second best time of his career (18:45) to place 24th overall. Senior Casey Vaughn was next for the Titan in 32nd place. Freshman Aiden Kelly and sophomore Liam Royse rounded out the Collins scoring.

The Collins girls did not score since only four girls toed the line (teams need five runners to finish the race to score). Senior Sophie Bolin ran a strong race and was the first Titan across the finish line in third place (20:17). Bolin was followed by sophomore Margo Treece in 23:59 (31st place) and freshman Lisa Smith in 24:52 (40th). Sophomore Josie Renda got a season best time of 25:58 to finish 48th for the Titans.
