Rumble Through the Jungle

The Collins cross country team traveled to the Creasy Mahon Nature Preserve in Goshen on Sept. 6th to compete in the Rumble Through the Jungle Invitational. The boys' team finished 21st out of 30 teams with 587 points.

In the boys' race, junior Reece Delaney finished in the top five (5th) with a time of 16:37. Collins' next two finishers, senior Casey Vaughn (19:42) and freshman Aiden Kelly (22:23) both got personal bests (PB) in the race.

The girls finished 17th (492 points) out of 23 teams. The girls were led by senior Sophie Bolin who bettered her time from last year coming in 18th with a 20:12 clocking for the 5K race. Freshman Lisa Smith got a PB time of 25:13, knocking seven seconds off her previous best. Sophomore Josie Renda was the last scorer for Collins with a season best time of 28:37.
